




MY MONEY JAR PROJECT!

INSTRUCTIONS

1

Find a 32oz mason jar or some sort of can!

2

Talk to your child about creating a savings goal. Is there something they want/need? Research the cost!

3

Print out your savings tracker on paper or a 4"X6" label. Tape or stick the tracker to the jar!

4

Help your children with the math. Divide the number of fish(150) by the total amount of your child's savings goal. Fill how much each fish is worth.

5

Your child will color in a fish every time they put in a fish worth of money. When all the fish are filled in, your child has reached their goal.

You should encourage your children to deposit their extra funds into a savings account at their financial institution.

Once you they reach one goal, work with them to set another and start all over again!
